“The Science of Bouncibility - How to Build Resilience within Ourselves”

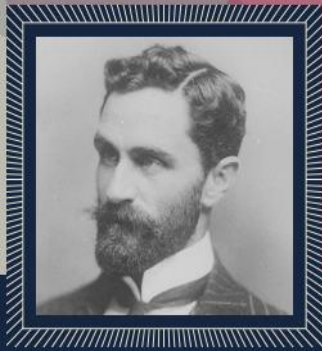
Monday 11 September 2017
