

## TALK ON MENTAL HEALTH

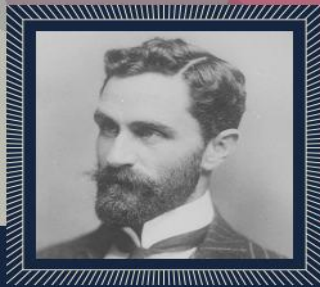
*“The Science of Bouncibility - How to Build Resilience within Ourselves”*
