A new European Data Protection law, the **General Data Protection Regulation** (“GDPR”), is being introduced on 25 May 2018. This new law applies to any organisation, including our parish that manages and processes people's personal information. The Archdiocese is now working on ways of ensuring we will have proper policies and procedures in place to ensure that our processing of this information is compliant with the new law. It is a work in progress and, over the next few months, we will keep you informed through the parish website and the newsletter as policies are put in place.
