# Matthew 13:24-30



***The Parable of Weeds among the Wheat***

He put before them another parable: ‘

*The kingdom of heaven may be compared to someone who sowed good seed in his field; but while everybody was asleep, an enemy came and sowed weeds among the wheat, and then went away.*



***So when the plants came up and bore grain, then the weeds appeared as well.***



**Weeds will grow in all places, despite how much weeding we do!**

**Our lives are filled with both love and selfishness! We have to learn to live with both together!**

And the slaves of the householder came and said to him: *Master, did you not sow good seed in your field? Where, then, did these weeds come from?*



Weeds are sown when we are not watching:

- By birds
- By the wind
- On the feet of animals
- By those who are jealous of us...

Weeds grow in our hearts when we are selfish, fail to give time to others, fail to love, fail to do our best, fail to be thankful, fail to believe in ourselves, fail to accept that our lives have a great purpose.....



He answered: *An enemy has done this.*

The slaves said to him: *Then do you want us to go and gather them?*



**But he replied: *No; for in gathering the weeds you would uproot the wheat along with them. Let both of them grow together until the harvest.***
