Matthew 15:21-28



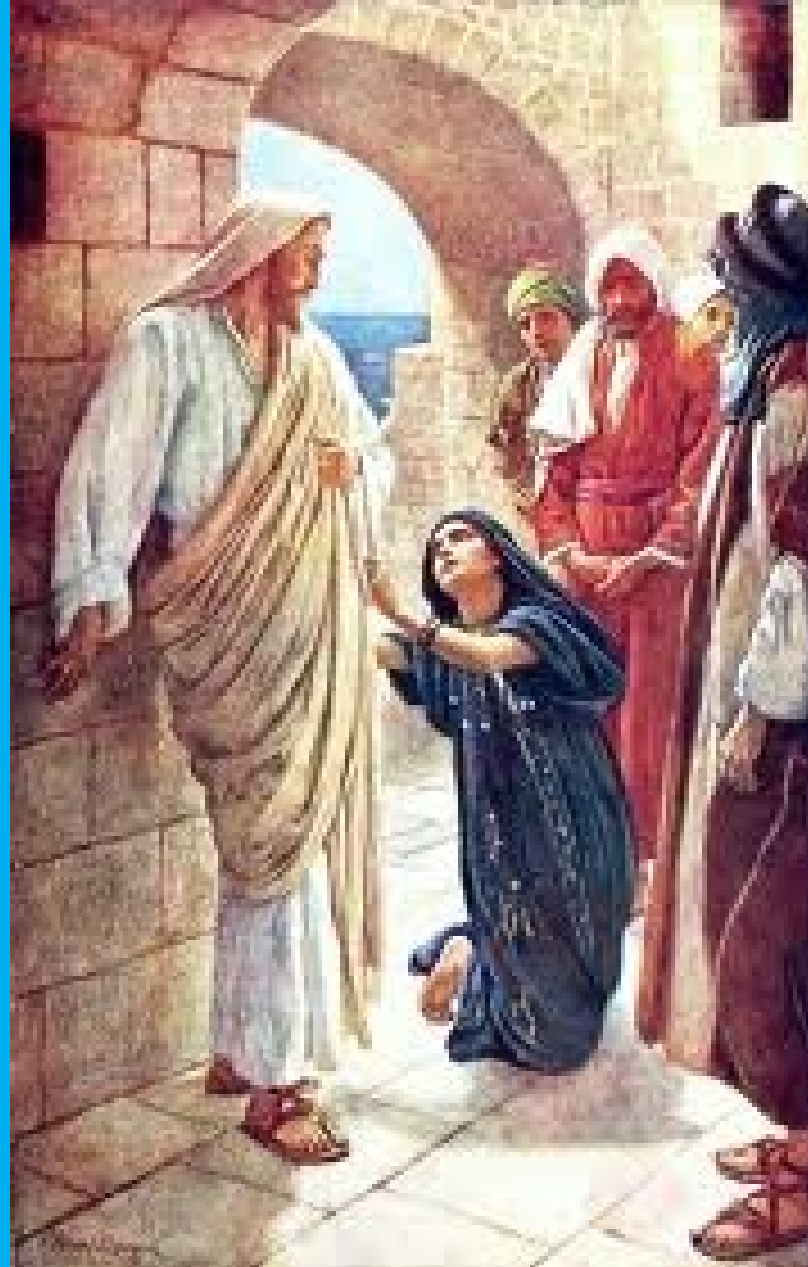
The Canaanite Woman's Faith
