But who do you say that I am?

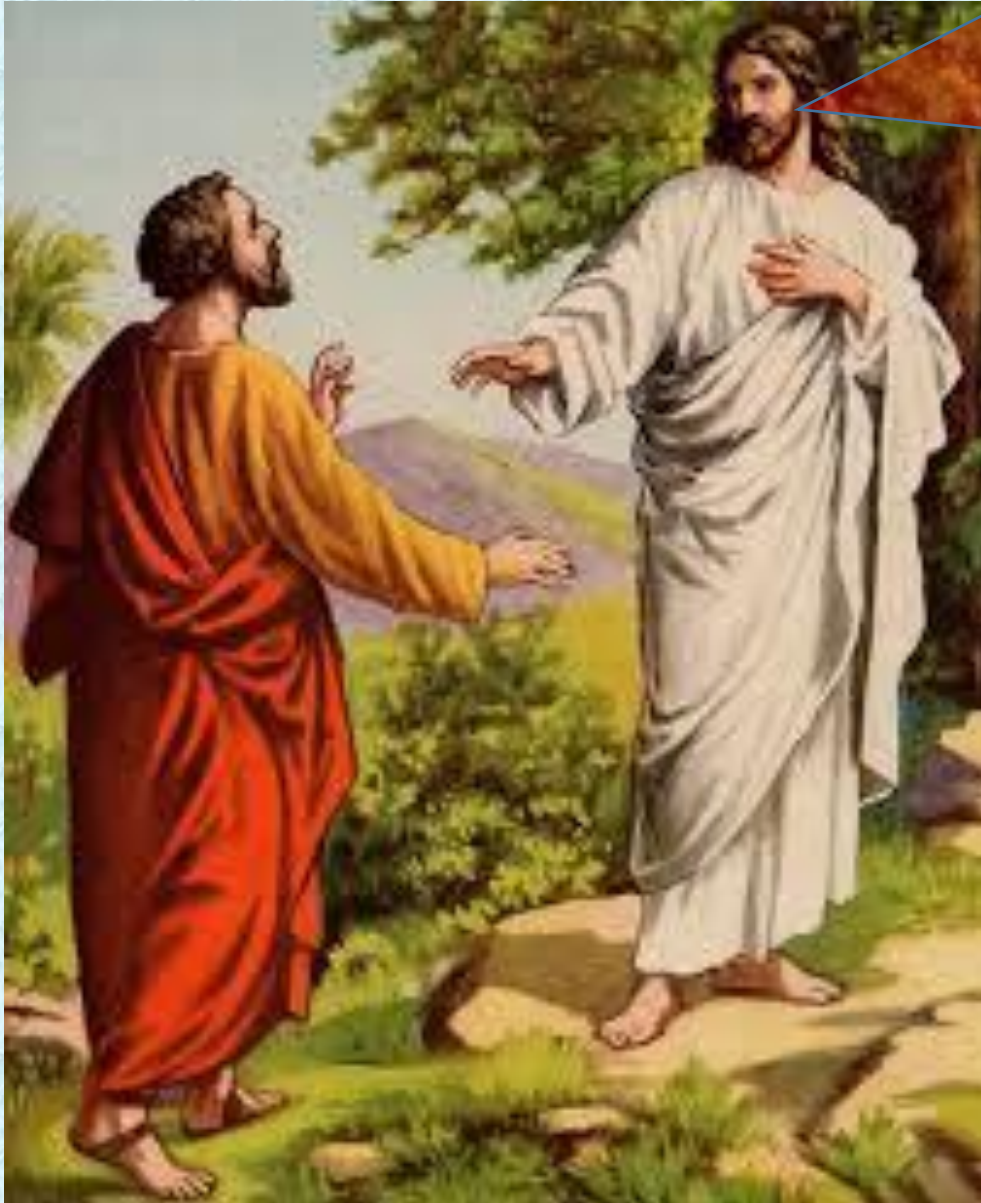
***You are the Messiah,
