
Getting Ready for Sunday!

The Canaanite Woman's Faith


Jesus left Gennesaret and withdrew to the region of Tyre and Sidon. Then out came a Canaanite woman from that district and started shouting:

Sir, Son of David, take pity on me. My daughter is tormented by a devil.






But he answered her not a word.



And his disciples went and pleaded with him.


Give her what she wants, because she is shouting after us.
