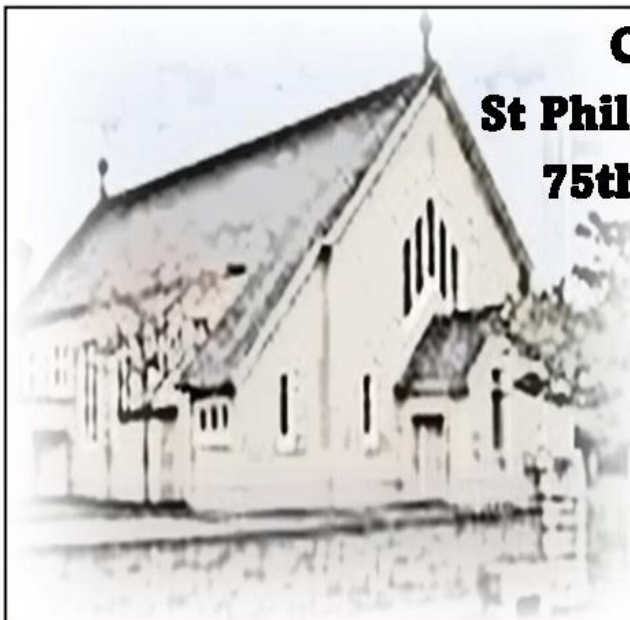

REVENUE TAX BACK SCHEME

- CHY FORMS

We are currently in the process of claiming back Tax from Revenue for the last three years (2020/2021/2022). Revenue CHY3 Forms were sent out to those who have contributed €250 or more in donations to the Parish during the above years.

We would be most grateful if you would complete and return them as soon as possible. If you are paying Income Tax on wages/a salary whether you are self-employed or a PAYE worker; or are in receipt of a private pension, as a registered charity we can claim a tax rebate.

This means the value of your donation will be increased - for example, if you donate at least €250 (minimum qualifying amount) in the tax year and paid tax at a rate of 42%, Our Parish is entitled to a repayment of €181 making your total donation €431. Similarly, the total value of a donation if you paid tax at a rate of 20% is €312.50. Please note that this repayment does not cost you a penny in tax or affect your tax status in any way.

In the current environment, "every bit helps!" and every returned form makes an incredible difference to the finances of our Parish.

Thank you to those who have already returned these forms. If you have received a form, please return it to us as soon as possible.

As always, we are very grateful to all our Parishioners for their continued ongoing support to our Parish.
