

Testimony of John the Baptist



The Third purple candle will be lit this Sunday marking the beginning of the third week of preparing for Christmas.

The third Sunday of is called *Gaudete Sunday*, meaning *Joyful Sunday*.

We celebrate the facts that -

- we are coming closer to Christmas!
- we have made efforts to repent (change) and be riendship with our loving Creator.
- We have an opportunity to make a fresh start.

The pink/rose candle on the Advent wreath is lit this week along with the two purple/violet candles.

There was a man sent from God, whose name was John. He came as a witness to testify to the light, so that all might believe through him. He himself was not the light, but he came to testify to the light.



God sent John the Baptist, to show the way to Jesus.

Each one of us has also been sent to show others where Jesus may be found!

This is the testimony given by John when the Jews sent priests and Levites from Jerusalem to ask him:

Who are you?

He confessed but confessed, '

and did not deny it:

I am not the Messiah.


We sometimes forget that we can depend on God, the source of all goodness and power.

What then? Are you Elijah?


No.

I am the voice of one crying out in the wilderness, "Make straight the way of the Lord" ',as the prophet Isaiah said.


Who are you? Let us have an answer for those who sent us. What do you say about yourself?

SEEING YOUR LIFE THROUGH THE LENS OF THE GOSPELS

John 1:6-8, 19-28

- 1 John the Baptist came to bear witness to Jesus. Who have been the people who have borne witness to you of the good news of the gospel that God loves you a friend, a parent, a teacher, etc.? To whom have you borne that witness?
- 2 John appears in the story as one who had the courage to be himself in the face of loud and aggressive people. He was also a person who knew his own value, did not make exaggerated claims and was content with his mission. Can you recall times when you have been able to be yourself, even in the face of criticism from others?
- 3 John was 'the voice of one crying out in the wilderness' announcing confidently to those in the wilderness that they must not despair because God's grace may come to them at any moment. Have you had the experience of being in the wilderness, feeling lost? From whom did you hear a voice that gave you hope? Have you been able to give hope to other people when they were in the wilderness?
