
SECOND SUNDAY OF EASTER



Doubt no longer but believe! Jesus says to Thomas in the Gospel for Sunday.

Jesus is not harsh with Thomas but gladly allows him to experience the truth in the flesh of the one who stands before him.

Doubt is not the worst position to be in as it assumes actual thought and consideration about something. Doubt is an almost inevitable stage in the consideration of anything which is important in life. Indifference is the lukewarm state which is unproductive and often stifling. Doubt is quite a natural phase in faith life, particular at times of transition, times of turbulence, times of bereavement, etc. Doubt is the trowel digging into the soil of belief to see if there are any roots or strength in the growth. Indifference is like a root rot which causes lifeless greying growth.

Do you believe that Jesus is God made man? Do you believe that God is truly with us – right here and now – in living Spirit – guiding us, loving us, supporting us and challenging us? Do you believe that God is present in each person and particularly calling to us through those who suffer or are marginalised? We put our fingers in the wounds of Jesus, as did Thomas, when we reach out to those in need and when we come to the table of the Eucharist with real openness to changing ourselves so that we may be Christ's healing and love for one another.

Alleluia! Jesus is risen! Jesus lives among us!
