CHURCHGATE COLLECTION NEXT WEEKEND

Margaret O'Brien will hold a Church Gate Collection at all masses next weekend (19/20 April 2024) to raise funds for the Ambo Deaf Kindergarten School in Ethiopia.

The cost of inflation in Ethiopia is running at 36% and so all families and institutions are struggling to cope with the cost-of-living crisis and the increased price of food and resources etc.

Margaret Anne is raising funds in order to ensure none of the poorest of the children in the village will drop out of education due to the cost-of-living crisis, which is very severe for many of the families. Many parents were facing the prospect of withdrawing their child as they were struggling just to feed them. It costs €100 per child per year.

Margaret Anne is very committed to the children, many of whom she knows from her visits to Ambo.
