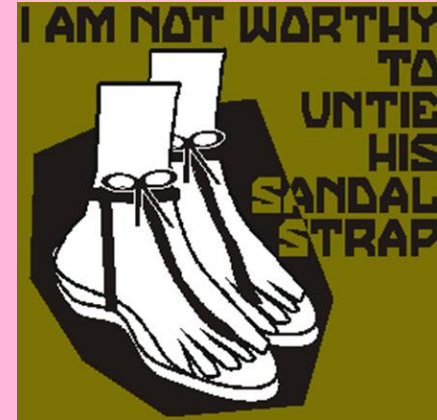


Getting Ready for Sunday!



The Third Sunday of Advent

Matthew 11:2-11

The Third purple candle
will be lit this Sunday
marking the beginning of
the third week of
preparing for Christmas.

The third Sunday of is called *Gaudete Sunday*, meaning *Joyful Sunday*.



We celebrate the facts that -

- we are coming closer to Christmas!
- we have made efforts to repent (change) and become closer in friendship with our loving Creator.
- We have an opportunity to make a fresh start.

The *pink/rose candle* on the Advent wreath is lit this week along with the two *purple/violet candles*.

When John heard in prison what the Messiah was doing, he sent word by his disciples and said to him:



*Are you the one who
is to come, or are we
to wait for another?*

Jesus answered them:

Jesus offered a message of JOY for John when he was in prison for his faith.

Jesus offered healing, health, resurrection and joy to all whom He met.

Do you lift people in your company up with hope, joy, peace and love?

Go and tell John what you hear and see: the blind receive their sight, the lame walk, the lepers are cleansed, the deaf hear, the dead are raised, and the poor have good news brought to them. And blessed is anyone who takes no offence at me.



As they went away, Jesus began to speak to the crowds about John:

What did you go out into the wilderness to look at? A reed shaken by the wind?

Can you see Him?

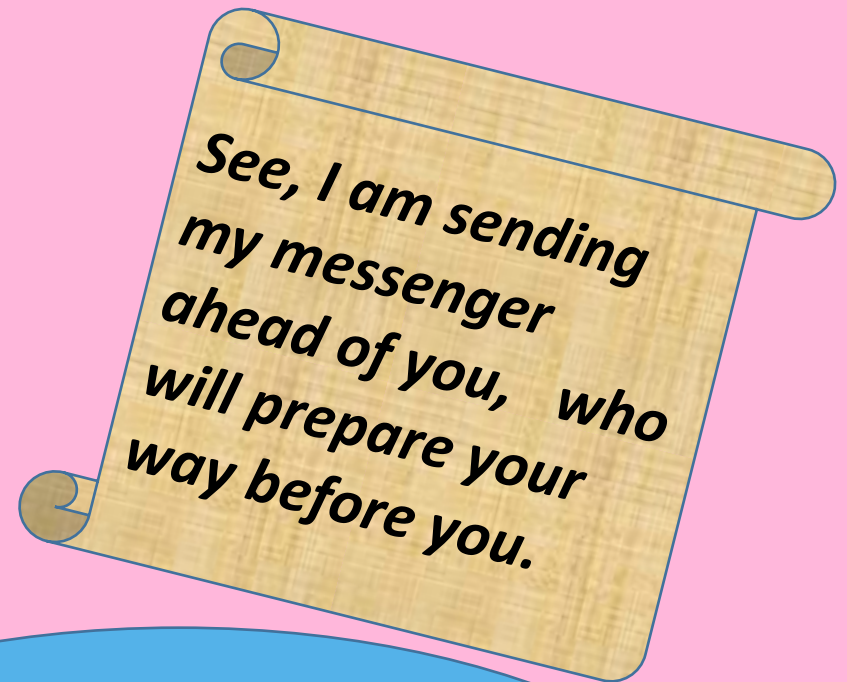
***What then did you go out to see?
