Fifth Sunday in Ordinary Time

Jesus uses images that speak to the people to whom He was speaking.

The fishermen, Jesus disciples, knew all about salt water because sea water is salty. They would have made salt by drying sea water.

What is salt used for?

- To give flavour to food**
- To clean wounds and aid healing**
- To preserve food for use at a later stage**
- To clean stubborn dirt by abrasion**
- To help our bodies absorb water**
- To provide an environment for salt loving creatures, e.g. fish....**

Salt is vital for life and for quality of life!

**Jesus often uses the image of light to talk about what is of God.
The image of light tells us something about God.**

What does light do for us?

Shows us the way

Helps us to see all clearly

Prevents us from stumbling and falling

Puts us in good humour

Allows us to see the beauty of one another and of creation

Enables us to use our sense of sight to read, play, etc.

others!**

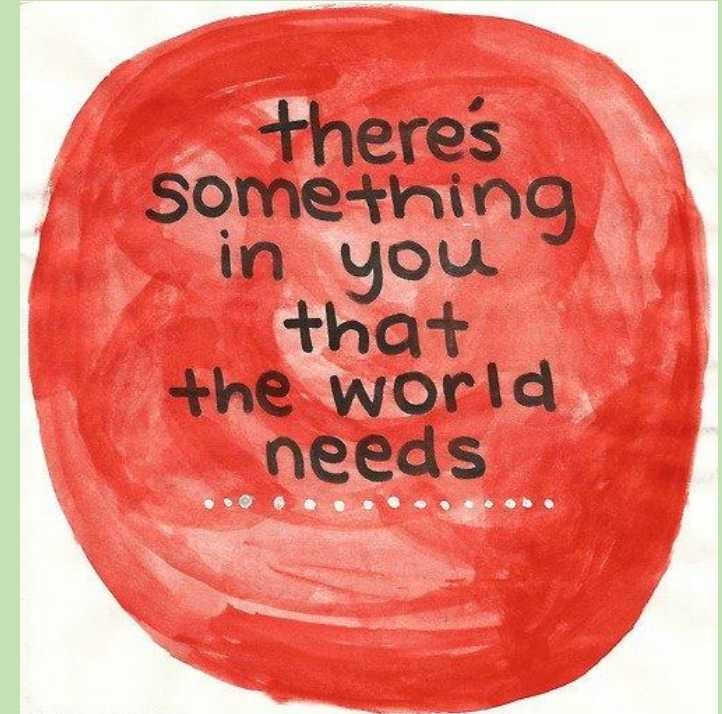
**If you have an
