CELEBRATING THE EASTER VIGIL!

The Easter Vigil is a celebration of the Mass which gives account of our entire Christian history through selected Bible passages. It is full of wonderful symbolism:

FIRE

- the lighting of the Easter fire outside the church
- the lighting of candles held by each member of the congregation.
- While the church starts in darkness, it lights up as the candle light spreads with joyful singing.

WATER OF BAPTISM

The holy water will be blessed reminding us of our Baptism as we renew our Baptismal Promises.

This year we are blessed to have the company of the young people in **AONTAS Choir** from St Mary's and St Patrick's Parishes, Lucan to lead us in beautiful music and singing. They sang at the RTE Sunday TV Mass numerous times and, more recently, in the Vatican last year. This Easter, they will be singing with our congregation (just clarifying it's here & not in Lucan).
