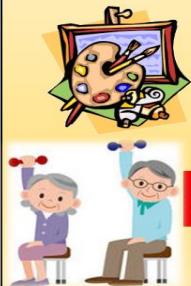

FUNERAL POLICY IN OUR PARISH



As you know funerals are celebrated on the following days in our parish: Monday, Wednesday, Thursday, Friday and Saturday. Funerals will not be celebrated on Tuesdays as it is Fr Tony's day of rest and, also, the day on which members of the Funeral Team know that they too are free. This has been the policy for some years now as it guarantees that a priest will be present to celebrate the funeral and gives respect to the voluntary service of our small but dedicated Funeral Team.

In the event that Fr Tony is away, or knows that he will be absent, he always makes firm arrangements with a priest on whom he can rely so that there can be no disappointment for the families concerned.

Funerals take place at 10.00am so that it brings the funeral celebration into the heart of the faith community.

All local funeral directors have been made aware of the parish policy to facilitate planning with bereaved families.
